- 🐾 I-91 South & North
Take Exit 10 toward Mt. Carmel/Hamden onto CT-40
Take Exit 1 toward US-5 / State Street /
Dixwell Avenue / Hamden
Turn Right onto Devine Street
In 0.1 miles, take a Left onto State Street.
Entrance to Central Hospital for Veterinary Medicine
will be on the LEFT after 0.25 miles.
- 🐾 CT-15 N/Wilbur Cross Pky toward Hartford.
Take the Dixwell Ave exit, EXIT 62.
Turn left onto Dixwell Ave.
In 0.75 miles, turn left onto State Street.
Entrance to Central Hospital for Veterinary Medicine
will be on the LEFT after 0.4 miles.
- 🐾 CT-15 S/Wilbur Cross Pky toward North Haven.
Take EXIT 63 toward CT-22/North Haven.
Take the 1st left onto Hartford Turnpike.
Turn the First Left onto Bishop Street
Turn Right onto State Street after 0.25 miles
Entrance to Central Hospital for Veterinary Medicine
will be on your right in 0.75 miles.

WHAT IS REHABILITATION?

Animal rehabilitation has existed in small animal medicine in the United States since the late 1990's. However, it has only gained popularity for companion animals in recent years.

Animal rehabilitation is the practice of adapting human rehabilitation techniques and applying them to animals. This process can help to increase function and reduce pain in our pets. The main goal in rehabilitation is to help our patients return to normal or as near normal function in a much faster amount of time than if rehabilitation was not implemented. Rehabilitation can also play an important role in the reduction of pain in certain situations. We use minimally to non-invasive techniques to reach our goals. Each program is individually tailored to meet the needs of the patient.

Some of the conditions that may benefit from rehabilitation include

- 🐾 Osteoarthritis
- 🐾 Post-Operative cranial cruciate ligament rupture repair
- 🐾 Spinal cord diseases such as IVDD, FCE, DM, Spinal Trauma and Inflammatory CNS Disease
- 🐾 Post-Operative femoral head and neck osteotomy
- 🐾 Fracture Repair
- 🐾 Obesity

We begin with an initial evaluation of each patient and determine the needs of the patient based on our findings. Our initial visit includes evaluation of the patient by our therapy team, the development of a treatment plan and the initial therapy session.
